Dr. Andrews previously served as the Program Director for the PULPIT (Program for Urban Leaders and Pastors in Transition) at Missio Seminary. Presently, she is the Program Administrator for the Ministers Council for the American Baptist Churches, USA, where she provides direct and administrative assistance to 2000+ clerics. Dr. Andrews serves on the United Theological Institute's Committee of Advisors of United Lutheran Seminary. She also serves as an instructor for United Lutheran Seminary's Urban Theological Institute's Certificate Program, teaching Servant Leadership, Church Administration and Managing Church Conflict. In March, 2019, she was installed as the Pastor of the Eternal Life Missionary Baptist Church in Southwest Philadelphia.

As we look back we also look forward. We recognize the foundation that was laid by our two founders: Dr. Allan MacRae and Dr. Jack Murray; the former was a scholar and the latter an evangelist.
